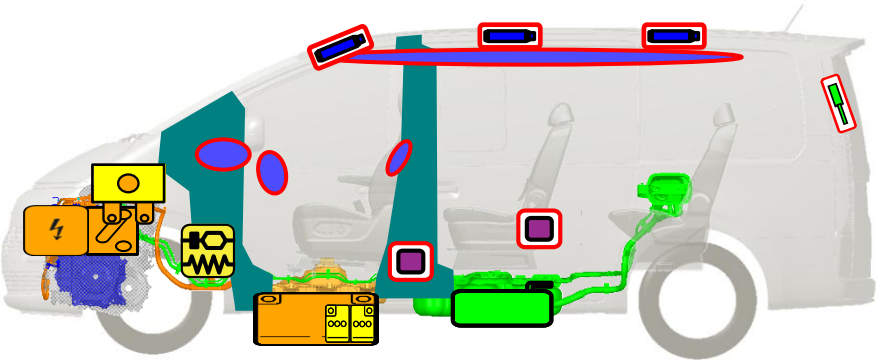
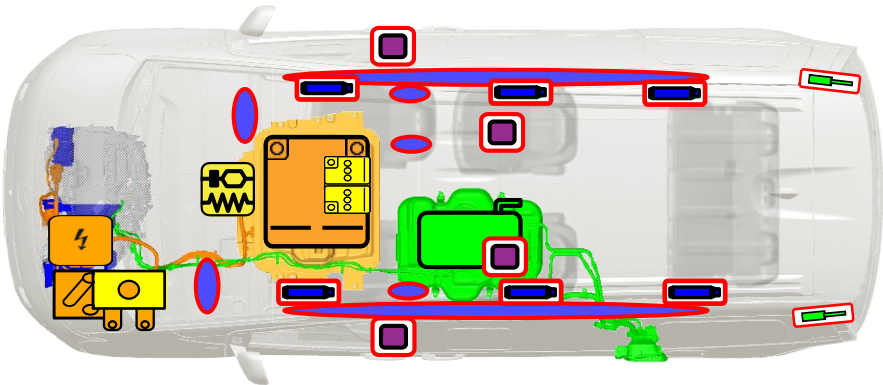


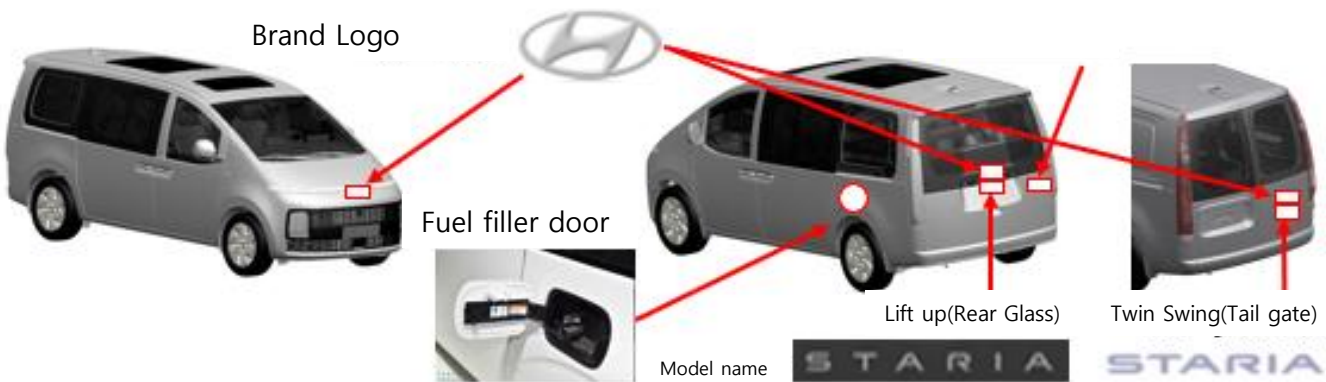

1. After stopping the vehicle, press the brake pedal (1) and pull the electronic parking brake switch (2).

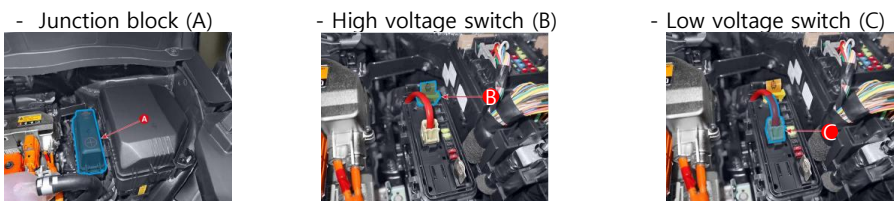

■ High-voltage switch and low-voltage battery access method

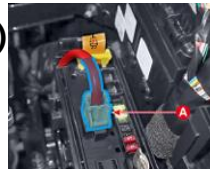
- ① Pull the hood release lever on the driver's side.
- ② Push the secondary hood release lever to the left while lifting the hood from the front of the vehicle.
- ③ Wear a fire hydrant helmet and remove the sub junction block (A) cover.
- ④ The high voltage stich(B) and the low voltage switch(C) are located inside the sub junction block box (A)



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■ Disabling Method (Start Off)

■ Battery low voltage



- Disconnect the cable(A) of the 12V battery.

■ Battery high voltage



- ① 1 High voltage connection status.
- ② Pull the switch up to cut off the high voltage.



"High Voltage cut-off switch" does not fully release.

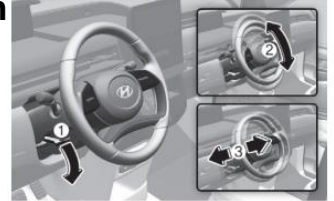

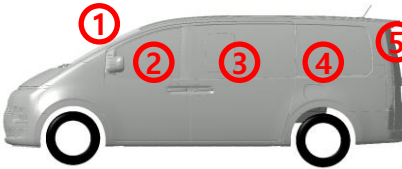


■ Door Handle (Emergency Key)



1. Press the lever under the cover as the emergency key ①.
2. To remove the cover, press the lever and gently push it toward the rear of the vehicle (2) to prevent the emergency key from falling out.
3. In an emergency, you can lock or unlock the driver's door using the key after removing the cover.

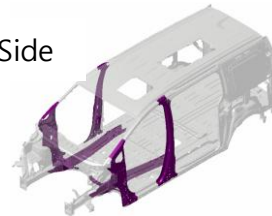

7. In case of submersion



Do not touch any of the high-voltage components or cables including the high voltage cut-off switch, as doing so poses an electrocution hazard. Work on the vehicle only after the vehicle has been pulled out of the water.

8. Towing / transportation / storage

OK :



The use of wheel dollies(A) or flatbed is recommended. Use a wheel lift or flatbed equipment.

Not OK :



Do not tow using the suspension restraint system. The bumper and underbody components could be damaged.

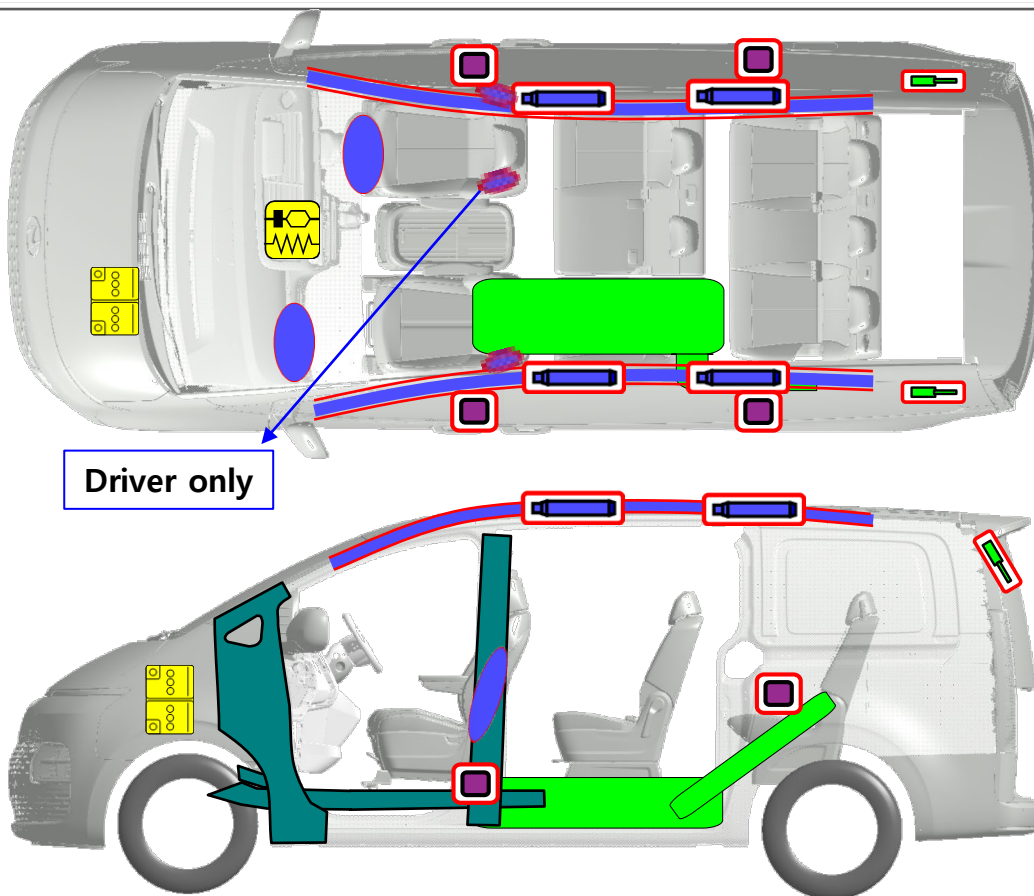

■ Immobilisation



1. Chock the wheels and pull the switch to set the parking brake.
2. For automatic vehicles the shift lever to the park(P) position.

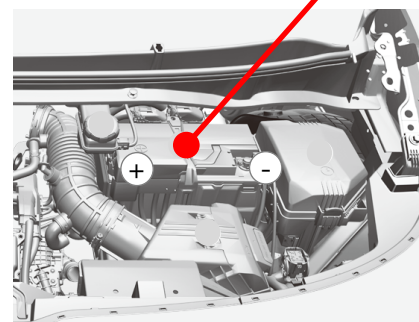
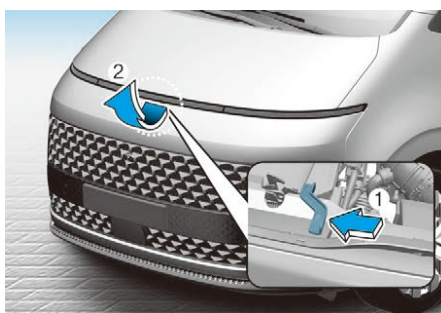


Do not place cribbing such as wooden blocks or rescue air lifting bags under the exhaust system, fuel system or high voltage power cables. The failure will cause of fire, electric shock or gas leak.

1. Pull the release lever to unlatch the hood. The hood should pop open slightly.
2. Go to the front of the vehicle, raise the hood slightly, push the secondary latch (1) up side and lift the hood (2).
