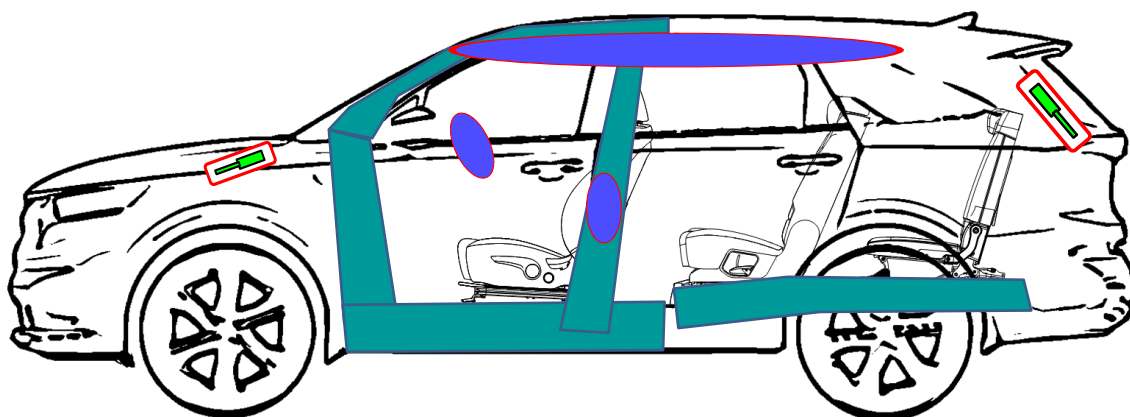
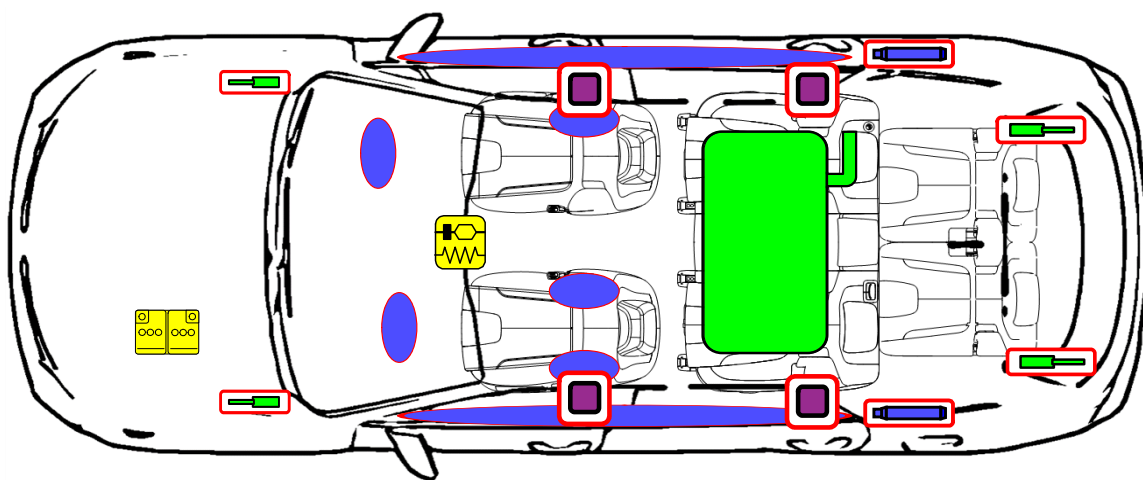

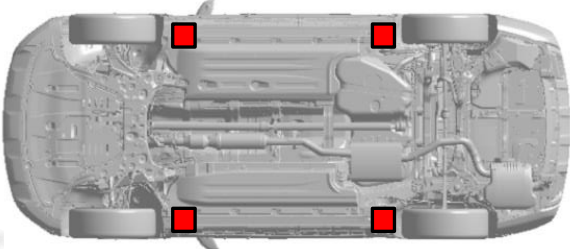
- 1. Move the shift lever to the P position.

- 2. Chock the wheels and pull the switch to set the parking brake.

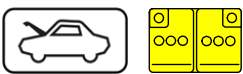

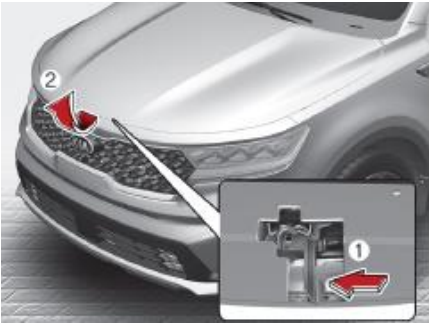

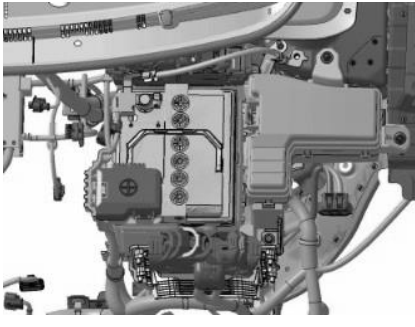

1. Pull the release lever to unlatch the hood. The hood should pop open slightly.

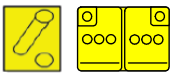


2. Raise the hood slightly, push the secondary latch up (①) inside of the hood center and lift the hood (②)

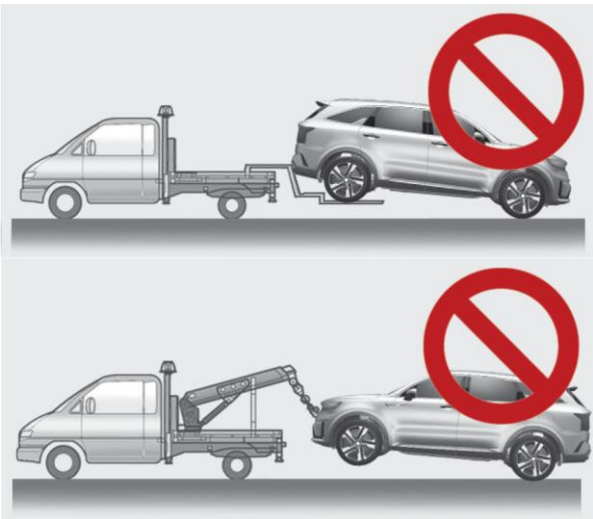


The use of wheel dollies (1) or flatbed is recommended.

It is acceptable to tow the vehicle with the rear wheels on the ground (without dollies) and the front wheels off the ground.

If any of the loaded wheels or suspension components are damaged or the vehicle is being towed with the front wheels on the ground, use a towing dolly under the front wheels.

Not OK :



Do not tow the vehicle backwards with the front wheels on the ground as this may cause damage to the vehicle.

Do not tow with sling-type equipment with the rear wheels on the ground as this may cause damage to the vehicle. Use wheel lift or flatbed equipment.
